ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was to analyze student learning activities in online learning at Kampung Naga during the Covid-19 pandemic, the obstacles encountered and how to solve them. Kampung Naga is a traditional village where the people still adhere to tradition. The condition of the Covid-19 pandemic has greatly impacted the education sector. Learning activities during the pandemic were carried out using distance learning (PJJ) online and offline. School children who live in Kampung Naga must also take distance learning online. The method used is descriptive method with a qualitative approach. The data collection techniques used were observation, interviews, documentation, data triangulation, and data analysis techniques using the Miles and Hubermen models with the stages of data collection, reduction/condensation, data display, and conclusive/verifying. The research results show that; Online learning activities are carried out by all students starting from elementary, junior high, and high school/vocational school levels with a different length of study time for each level. The infrastructure used is cellphones, laptops, internet quota. Online learning techniques at each level generally use WhatsApp as the main application and other additional applications. The obstacles encountered are that not all students have personal cellphones and limited quotas. The psychological condition of students, the geographical conditions of Kampung Naga cause the signal to be unstable. funds to purchase internet quota, lack of mastery of technology. The solution that was found and carried out was carrying out traveling teachers/teachers visiting Kampung Naga, using various applications and media, taking advantage of quota assistance from the government, going out of the village to charge cellphone batteries, choosing the provider with the most stable signal, studying together with friends who have cell phones for students who do not have personal cell phones.
