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ABSTRAK

Dalam penelitian sebelumnya, studi tentang ekspresi wajah telah diteliti dalam berbagai aspek. Salah satu penelitian sebelumnya berfokus pada perubahan perubahan ekspresi wajah pada kartun komik (Feng & O’Halloran 2012). Namun, hanya ada beberapa studi yang berfokus pada ekspresi wajah siswa, bukan berfokus kepada ekspresi wajah pada kartun komik. Untuk itu, tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui ekspresi wajah siswa yang dihasilkan selama proses belajar mengajar didalam kelas Bahasa Inggris. Satu murid di pilih dan di rekam ekspresi wajahnya selama proses belajar mengajar didalam kelas. Data dikumpulkan menggunakan video dimana bagian ekspresi wajah yang paling sering muncul di potong-potong menjadi sebuah foto. Kemudian semua data dianalisis menggunakan kerangka Martinec (Martinec, 2001) untuk mendapatkan makna interpersonal didalam ekspresi wajah siswa. Kontribusi keseluruhan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk memberikan informasi gambaran respon siswa dalam ekspresi wajah terhadap serangkaian interaksi antara siswa dan guru dalam proses belajar mengajar.
