A Speech Acts Analysis of Anies Baswedan's Speech at the C40 Virtual Forum in 2021

Rasional

Ahead of the general election, which will be held simultaneously in 2024, many media are highlighting this occasion, especially in the predictions of the presidential and vice presidential candidates. Several names are predicted to advance in the presidential election, which always ranks in the top three in the electability figures of presidential candidates according to surveys from various institutions. One of the three is Anies Baswedan, who declared himself a presidential candidate from the *Nasdem* party in October 2022. In response to this, digital footprints have once again been active, showing the figure of Anies, the former governor of DKI Jakarta, one of which is from the way he made his speech. In a political context, politicians usually use speech as a tool to influence other people's opinions. The speech was prepared to convince, promise, emphasize certain

things, and even threaten. Speech acts in politicians' speeches are conveyed to give different interpretations to the listeners. Some previous studies conducted by researchers regarding political speech using speech act analysis. Many of them only focus on commissive speech act analysis because political speeches contain many commissive speeches involving promises, guarantees, threats, etc. This is in line with research conducted by Hashim (2015), Okoro (2017), Sameer (2017), (Ulum & Warsono, 2018), Rais & Triyono (2019), Firdaus et al. (2020), which analyzes speeches politics in the form of presidential campaigns, victory speeches, inaugural speeches, etc. The result of this research is proven to be dominated by commissive and representative speech acts. However, there is also similar research, which analyzing political speech that is not a campaign speech, as was done by Kotchadé (2017), who examined the speech acts in Buhari's Address at the 71st Session of the UN General Assembly and Alafnan & Oshchepkova (2022) who investigated the General Assembly Emergency Special Session on Ukraine Speech. However, the two studies only focus on discussing illocutionary analysis. Therefore, in this study, the researcher intends to examine the Speech Act using Austin's (1962) Speech Act classification theory and Searle's (1969) Speech Act illocutionary classification theory to identify the speech acts feature in the speech of Anies Baswedan in C40 Virtual Forum of the United Nation (UN).

Rumusan Masalah

How speech acts be presented in the Anies Baswedan's Speech in C40 Cities Virtual Forum to reach his intended social action?

Landasan Teori dan Konsep

In communication activities, the speakers not only produce utterances but also perform actions through the utterances. It is referred to in pragmatics as a speech event or what is often heard as a speech act. Yule (2006: 82) says that speech acts are actions carried out through utterances. Rais and Triyono (2019) state that speech acts are utterances defined in terms of the speaker's intent and effect on the listener. It is an utterance product of a sentence under certain conditions. It is the smallest unit of language communication that determines the meaning of a sentence in both spoken and written forms. Speech acts are pragmatic elements that involve speakers, listeners or writers, readers, and the person being talked to. Searle developed Austin's ideas to provide a more

precise and in-depth understanding of the different types of speech acts and their role in speech. In Austin's (1962) theory, speech acts comprise locutionary, illocutionary, and perlocutionary. Searle (1976) believes that the classification is well defined by dividing illocutionary speech into five categories: assertive, directive, commissive, expressive, and declarative. In this research, Austin's (1962) and Searle's (1976) speech acts classification was used in this research to analyze the video documentation of Anies Baswedan, the Governor of DKI Jakarta, at the C40 Cities virtual forum in 2021. Political speech can be seen as a means to build and maintain social relations, express feelings, and sell ideas, policies, and programs (Ulum & Warsono, 2018). It makes political speech used by politicians to communicate directly with the general public to convince the public (Firdaus et al., 2020). Political speeches can be easily found at specific periods, such as during presidential elections because the issues of presidential candidates will become the main issues discussed in the media (Ulum & Warsono, 2018). The speech of the video can be called as a political speech. The video can be concluded on how Anies gave his approved proposal on the steps the United Nations must take to support cities to achieve climate action. The success of conveying ideas so that they can influence the Secretary General of the United Nations to approve their proposals is exciting to analyze from a speech act point of view.

Desain Penelitian

This research uses a qualitative descriptive approach as a research design. A descriptive study provides a depth and breadth overview of problems, facts, events, and real situations to obtain a new understanding (Raco, 2010). Furthermore, qualitative methodology produces descriptive data from a person's written or spoken words and observable behavior (Bogdan and Taylor in Moleong, 1990). This research is qualitative descriptive because it describes linguistic phenomena found in a political speech and observes the utterances in the video. Then, it must be interpreted using the author's description. Even though the discussion in qualitative studies may sound subjective, objectivity is reflected in the in-depth examination of the text in a contextual framework that would add credibility to the findings.

Metode Pengambilan Data dan Analisis Data

This study's primary data source was a video of speech attached from VIVA.CO.ID YouTube channel entitled "Pidato 2 Menit Anies Baswedan Bikin Sekjen PBB Terpukau". Austin's (1962) three-way classification of Speech Act and Searle's (1976) illocutionary speech acts classification will be used to analyze the data. According to Sudaryanto (1993:20), three steps can be done in collecting data: (1) collecting the data and taking a note, (2) sorting the data and throwing the unused data, (3) taking notes based on its classifications. Then, according to Ulum and Warsono (2018) for analyses the data has five steps: (1) identifying various kinds of speech acts from the data, (2) classifying the data found into speech acts, (3) interpreting the speech act forces of the data, and (4) drawing conclusions.

Tujuan dan Kontribusi

A. The Aim of The Study

This study aims to identify the features of speech acts in the speech of Anies Baswedan in the C40 virtual forum of the United Nations (UN).

B. Significance of The Research

1. Theoretically, this research contributes to another existing relevant study of speech acts and understanding pragmatics by defining a speaker's utterance in spoken form, particularly in political speeches.
2. Empirically, this research was conducted to identify the speech acts feature in the selected video with Austin's and Searle's speech acts classification.
3. Practically, the results of this study are important, it contributes to helping other researchers to have scientific references from within speech act in various contexts and theoretical basis.
