ABSTRACT

MOCHAMMAD ADITYA WIJAYA. 2023. The Correlation between Students' Motivation in Learning at an English Club and Students' Speaking Skills at One of Junior High School in Tasikmalaya. English Education Department, Faculty of Educational Sciences and Teachers' Training, Siliwangi University, Tasikmalaya.

The purpose of this research was to find out the correlation between students' motivation in learning at an English club and students' speaking skill at one of junior high schools in Tasikmalaya. The population of this research consists of 34 students who joined the English club. For the sample of the research, researchers only took 20 students, 10 students from eight grade and 10 students from ninth grade by using stratified random sampling. To collect the data, the researcher used two techniques, they were questionnaire and test. For the motivation case, the researcher used a questionnaire as the instrumentation of the research and speaking skills, the researcher used a speaking test. To analyze the data was used Pearson Product Moment using an SPSS application. After analyzing and calculating the data, it was found that coefficient correlation was 0.514 at a confidence level of 0.05 or 5%. It means that coefficient correlation was higher than 0.05 (0.514 > 0.05). So, there is a correlation between the two variables above. Therefore, the alternative hypothesis is accepted, which "There is correlation between students' motivation in learning at an English club and students' speaking skill".
