IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PUSKESMAS RECORDING AND REPORTING SYSTEM (SP3) IN THE TASIKMALAYA DISTRICT SERVICE IN 2022

The Puskesmas Recording and Reporting System (SP3) is a source of data and information collection at the Puskesmas level. Complete recording and reporting for the management of the Puskesmas, including the physical condition, personnel, facilities and main activities carried out as well as the results achieved by the Puskesmas. The problem that occurs at SP3 in Tasikmalaya Regency is that the Puskesmas that sent reports in the last 3 months was at most only 10% of the number of Puskesmas in the Tasikmalaya Regency area. The aim of this research was to determine the description of compliance of SP3 officers in the Community Health Center Recording and Reporting System through input, process and output elements. This research used a descriptive quantitative design. The research instrument used a questionnaire from the guidelines in PMK No. 31 of 2019 concerning SIMPUS. The research informants in this study were SP3 officers in the Tasikmalaya Regency Health Center area, consisting of 40 people. Data processing techniques through editing, scoring, coding, data entry, and cleaning. Data analysis used univariate analysis. The results of this research showed that the input elements of community health centers that meet standards in implementing SP3 are 28 community health centers (70%), the process elements of community health centers that have met standards in implementing SP3 are 30 community health centers (75%), and the output elements of community health centers that have met standards. in the implementation of SP3 there were 28 community health centers (70%). Puskesmas needs to monitor the recording and reporting of each program holder to SP3 officers. Apart from that, Puskesmas should be able to make maximum use of data processed from SP3. The Health Service needs to carry out supervision focused on SP3 as well as the need for technical assistance in data processing on a regular and scheduled basis. The health service needs to reorganize SP3 management procedures and strengthen the implementation of SP3 management procedures at the community health center level. Awards can be given to community health centers that have succeeded in managing SP3 and sanctions or warnings for community health centers that are late and incomplete in their reporting so that they can be an example for other community health centers.
