Childcare in Tangerang City is facing challenges due to the increasing number of divorce cases and parents' lack of knowledge and skills in child rights-based parenting. Child rights-based parenting emphasizes the fundamental rights of children, including the right to life, the right to growth and development, the right to protection, and the right to participation. This study aims to examine the efforts of the Family Learning Center (PUSPAGA) in improving the quality of child rights-based parenting in Tangerang City. The findings revealed that PUSPAGA's efforts to enhance child rights-based parenting encompass preventive measures such as family guidance socialization, parenting counseling, premarital guidance consultation, and parenting education. Outreach services and PUSPAGA Keliling (PUSPAGA on the Move) are utilized for dissemination, responding to complaints, and visiting families in need. Additionally, promotional efforts involve information services through social media, collaboration with other institutions and agencies, and consultation corners. PUSPAGA's strategies encompass preventive measures that involve socialization, support, and dissemination.
