IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DENGUE HEMORRHAGIC FEVER (DBD)
CONTROL PROGRAM THROUGH THE 1 HOUSE 1 JUMANTIK MOVEMENT
(CASE STUDY AT PUSKESMAS CIGEUREUNG TASIKMALAYA CITY IN 2023)

Dengue fever is still a serious health problem in Indonesia. To reduce the number of dengue cases, Tasikmalaya City actively controls dengue early by conducting prevention and control efforts through the 1 House 1 Jumantik Movement (G1R1J). Cigeureung Health Center located in Cipedes Sub-district, Tasikmalaya City is a health center that has experienced an increase in dengue cases in the last three years. The purpose of this study is how the implementation of the dengue control program through G1R1J at Puskesmas Cigeureung Tasikmalaya City in 2023. This research method uses descriptive qualitative design with purposive sampling interviewing 7 informants, namely jumantik cadres (main informants), head of Puskesmas and DHF program holders (triangulation informants). The results showed that the ABJ at the Cigeureung Health Center was $\leq 95\%$. The schedule, visits and recording/reporting of the results of larva monitoring were good. The program implementation procedure is in accordance with the technical guidelines of the Ministry of Health. Obstacles are the lack of public awareness of health. Transmission in communication has not been optimal. Implementing resources are adequate both in quantity and quality. Funds derived from BOK are considered inadequate. Facilities and resources of authority (SK) are not yet optimal. Disposition is good. The bureaucratic structure is not yet optimal, there is no organizational structure. It is expected that the Cigeureung Health Center can hold technical meetings involving cross-sectors, conduct ToT to cadres, communicate with certain parties related to additional budget sources, and is expected to make a decree in accordance with the technical guidelines of the Ministry of Health.
