The study aims to determine The Influence of Attitudes Toward the Teaching Profession and Learning Program Preparation on the Teaching Efficacy of Prospective Teachers. The research method used is a survey method with an explanatory design. The population in the study were students of the 2020 Economics Education Department, totaling 117 students. The sampling technique used was a non-probability technique using saturated samples. The research data collection technique used a questionnaire and the data analysis technique used was multiple linear regression analysis. The results showed that 1) There is a positive and significant influence between attitudes towards the teaching profession on the teaching efficacy of prospective teachers with a significance value of 0.001, 2) There is a positive and significant influence between learning program preparation on the teaching efficacy of prospective teachers with a significance value of 0.001, and 3) There is a significant influence between attitudes on the teaching profession and learning program preparation on the teaching efficacy of prospective teachers with a significance value of 0.001.
