

## **ABSTRACT**

This research aims to describe the local wisdom values of the Jamasan Heritage Ceremony of the Galuh Pakuan Museum in Ciamis Regency as a source of historical learning. This research uses descriptive qualitative research methods. Data collection was carried out by means of interviews, observation and documentation. The data analysis technique is the stages of data reduction, data presentation and drawing conclusions. The research results show that the Jamasan Heirloom Ceremony is an annual tradition carried out from generation to generation, where heirloom objects stored in the Galuh Pakuan Museum, Ciamis Regency are cleaned or purified every month of Maulid or Rabiul Awwal. Jamasan comes from the word jamas which means to purify. The aim of implementing this tradition is to preserve culture, on the other hand, to commemorate the birth of the Prophet Muhammad SAW. This tradition shows the manifestation of acculturation to Islamic culture, history and religion. The local wisdom values contained in the Jamasan Pusaka Ceremony are religious or spiritual values, social values, mutual cooperation values, love of nature or environmental care values, and historical values. The great meaning of this tradition makes the local wisdom values in the Jamasan Pusaka Ceremony very relevant and has the potential to be used as a source of historical learning.
