ABSTRACT

This study aims at investigating how students' behavioral engagement in group work. Data were analyzed using qualitative analysis by Miles, M. B., & Huberman, A. M. (1994). Based on the research findings, it can be concluded that the involvement of student behavior in the teaching and learning process in group work has three main aspects, namely students conduct in groupwork showing positive and negative attitudes, student participation in group work and student interest.
