ABSTRACT

THE EFFECT OF POVERTY LEVEL, ECONOMIC GROWTH, GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURES ON THE PROVINCE'S HUMAN DEVELOPMENT INDEX IN JAVA ISLAND 2011-2021

The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of poverty levels, economic growth, and government spending on the human development index in the Provinces of Java Island in the period 2011-2021. This research was conducted quantitatively using the Panel Data Regression (Pooled Data) method which is a combination of time series data and cross section data which was analyzed by the Random Effects Model (REM) which was processed with the Eviews 9.

The results of this study indicate that the poverty level has a negative and significant effect on the human development index, economic growth has a negative and significant effect on the human development index, then government spending has a positive and significant effect on the human development index. Together, the variables of poverty rate, economic growth, and government spending have a significant effect on the human development index.
