ABSTRACT

ANALYSIS OF THE EFFECT OF EXPORTS, FOREIGN DEBT, EXCHANGE RATE AND COVID-19 ON THE RATE OF ECONOMIC GROWTH IN INDONESIA IN 2007-2021

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This research aims to determine the effect of exports, foreign debt, exchange rates and Covid-19 partially and together on economic growth in Indonesia in 2007-2021. The method used is multiple linear regression analysis using E-views 10 software. This research uses a quantitative descriptive method with time series data types. The result of this study indicates that partially, export has a positive relationship and significant effect and the exchange rate has a positive relationship and has no significant effect. Meanwhile, the foreign debt and Covid-19 have a negative relationship and have significant effect on economic growth in Indonesia in 2007-2021. Taken together, exports, foreign debt, exchange rates, and Covid-19 have had a significant effect on economic growth in Indonesia in 2007-2021.
