ABSTRACT

This study analyzes the implementation of public policy Rwanda Vision 2020 during the Paul Kagame administration in Rwanda. Rwanda Vision 2020 is a long-term strategic plan that aims to transform Rwanda from a low-income country to a middle-income country through various economic, social, and political reforms. This study uses a qualitative method with a descriptive-analytical approach, collecting data through literature studies, in-depth interviews, and analysis of policy documents.
