Kampung Melayu is an urban village located in the Jatinegara District, East Jakarta. This village covers an area of 47.83 hectares. Residential areas in Kampung Melayu are still limited in access to clean water, sanitation, and adequate drainage systems. In addition, there are buildings constructed illegally along riverbanks, leading to informal settlements by the community. This study was conducted to identify the characteristics and socio-economic conditions of the community living in slum settlements in Kampung Melayu Urban Village, Jatinegara District, East Jakarta City. This is because there are still inadequate housing conditions in the Jatinegara District. It is expected that this study will encourage the government to revitalize uninhabitable settlements in order to create livable and sustainable environments. The research method used is a descriptive quantitative method with simple quantitative data analysis techniques. The population of this study consists of residents of Kampung Melayu Urban Village, Jatinegara District, East Jakarta City, with the research sample taken from residents of RW 08. The characteristics of slum settlements in Kampung Melayu include lack of basic services, semi-permanent housing conditions, densely packed buildings, absence of legal ownership, and poverty. The social conditions of the slum community include a high level of urbanization and relatively low educational attainment. The economic conditions include employment mainly in the informal sector and community income levels that are still below the minimum wage.
