This study aims to determine the effect of self efficacy, learning style, and metacognitive awareness on critical thinking ability in economic subjects. The research method used is a survey method with an associative research design. The population in this study were class XI students at SMA Negeri 5 Tasikmalaya City who took economic subjects totaling 116 people. Sampling using saturated samples. The data collection technique used in this study was a questionnaire and the data analysis technique used was multiple linear regression analysis. The results showed that there is a positive and significant effect between self efficacy on critical thinking ability with a significance value of 0.000, there is a positive and significant effect between learning styles on critical thinking ability with a significance value of 0.000 there is a positive and significant effect between metacognitive awareness on critical thinking ability with a significance value of 0.000 and there is a positive awareness on critical thinking ability with a significance value of 0.000.
