subjects. This study aims to determine the effect of learning environment on

learning achievement. This research is included in quantitative research using the

explanatory design survey method. The study population was all X and XI social

studies students totalling 64 people. The sampling technique used saturated sample

technique so that all populations were sampled. Data were obtained from

distributing questionnaires and analysed using simple regression analysis with the

help of SPSS version 30. The results of this study indicate that the learning

environment has a positive and significant effect on learning achievement. This can

be seen from the significance value obtained through hypothesis testing which

shows a significance value of 0.000 which is smaller than 0.05 and t count of 5.541

which exceeds t table 1.998, so it can be concluded that H0 is rejected and Ha is

accepted, which indicates that variable X or learning environment has a significant

influence on bel achievement.
