This research aims to determine: (1) How foreign direct investment, domestic investment, the productive age population, and local revenue in Banten Province were from 2013 to 2023. (2) The influence of foreign direct investment, domestic investment, and the productive age population on local revenue both simultaneously and partially in the Banten Provincial government from 2013 to 2023. The research method employed is a descriptive quantitative approach, and the data used in this study are secondary. The sampling technique used is purposive sampling. The analytical technique applied is multiple linear regression analysis using Eviews 12. The results of this study indicate that (1) Foreign direct investment shows fluctuations and tends to increase, domestic investment shows an increasing trend, the productive age population shows a consistent increasing trend during the study period, and regional original revenue shows an upward trend. (2) Foreign direct investment, domestic investment, and the productive age population simultaneously have a significant impact on regional original revenue. (3) Foreign direct investment partially does not have a significant effect on regional original revenue, domestic investment partially has a significant effect on regional original revenue, and the productive age population partially has a significant effect on regional original revenue.
