This study explores the differences between extrovert and introvert

students' speaking strategies in learning English in Junior High School. This

research was a mixed method design type of explanatory sequential, and

comparative study as the research design by involving 2 extrovert students and 2

introvert students of grade 9. The techniques used in collecting data were

questionnaires, interviews, and analysis using the analysis technique of Miles,

Huberman, and Saldana (2014). The results showed similarities and differences

between extrovert and introvert participants in their learning English speaking

strategies. Cognitive strategies and metacognitive strategies dominate the

similarities in the speaking strategies of extrovert and introvert students, while the

difference is that extrovert students do not use compensation strategies and introvert

students do not use social strategy. In the end, the contribution of this study is to

enhance the teaching-learning process to raise students' willingness to learn and use

English, which in this case includes English-speaking skills.
