

ABSTRACT

Tasikmalaya City is a city with a majority Muslim population as an area that has great potential in collecting and distributing zakat, infaq and shadaqah (ZIS). The city of Tasikmalaya is expected to be a pioneer in alleviating poverty through the National Amil Zakat Agency of Tasikmalaya City. Generally, it is to reduce poverty, including hunger. Several opinions and views have emerged trying to relate one by one of the SDGs points with the interpretation of the work of zakat, especially from the perspective of beneficiaries and the allocation of zakat. For example, there is an opinion that says that the role of zakat in the current SDGs focuses on the following objectives, namely: 1) Eliminating Poverty, 2) Ending Hunger, 3) Good Health and Welfare, 4) Quality Education.

This research uses a qualitative descriptive approach method, namely literature research that uses reference summaries from the latest journals and books, and observation by conducting in-depth interviews with members of the Tasikmalaya City BAZNAS by obtaining financial reports and zakat distribution reports.

The results of this study show that BAZNAS Tasikmalaya City plays a role in realizing *the Sustainable Development Goals* with BAZNAS programs that are in line with the SDGs. Among them, without poverty in line with the Tasik Peduli and Tasik Berkarakter Program, quality education related to the Smart Lake program, health and prosperous life related to the Healthy Lake Program, decent work and economic growth related to the Prosperous Lake Program.
