Mohamad Andriansyah. 2025, The Effect of Active Triangle Pasing and Square Active Passing Drill in Extracurricular Futsal Students at SMAN 9 Tasikmalaya City. Departement of Physical Education, Faculty of Teacher Training and Education, Siliwangi University, Tasikmalaya.

This study aims to evaluate the passing skill level of students participating in futsal extracurricular activities at SMAN 9 Kota Tasikmalaya. Passing is a fundamental skill in futsal that plays a crucial role in game fluency and team effectiveness. The research was initiated based on field observations and the coach's request to assess the students' passing quality. Training methods used included wall passing, group passing in triangle and square formations, aimed at improving players' technical skills. Analysis of pre-test and post-test scores from 18 participants showed a significant increase in average scores from 11.8 to 14.8. Statistical tests confirmed that the training intervention had a significant positive impact on passing performance. This study provides valuable insights for developing more effective training programs to enhance the performance of school-level futsal teams.
