

## **ABSTRACT**

*Elections or commonly referred to as legislative and presidential elections every 5 years, carried out directly in 2019, are a mechanism that functions as an implementation of democracy. The people have the right to elect those who will represent them in parliamentary seats through direct elections to carry out legislative, legal, supervisory and fiscal functions. Prisoners who are serving their sentences in correctional institutions still have the right to live and maintain their survival. The state, for any reason, may not make the prisoner's condition worse than before the prisoner entered a correctional institution. Therefore, legal protection for prisoners' rights is provided in Article 14 of Law Number 12 of 1995 concerning Corrections.*

*The method used in this research is a qualitative approach. The research was conducted at the Class IIB Banjar Correctional Institution. The focus of this research is on how to fulfill prisoners' right to vote in the Class IIB Banjar Penitentiary and what supporting and inhibiting factors are to fulfill prisoners' rights. The data sources in this research are primary data sources and secondary data sources. Data collection in this research used interview and documentation techniques. Validity of data with triangulation. The data analysis technique uses an interactive analysis model by collecting data, reducing data, presenting data and drawing conclusions.*

*In accordance with the research results, in fulfilling the right to vote for prisoners, all prisoners are given the right to vote in the 2019 Presidential Election as long as the prisoner is registered on the Permanent Voter List (DPT) or recorded when the Banjar City KPU records prisoners and detainees in Class II B Correctional Institutions. Banjar City. Even though the laws and regulations have explained that every citizen is given equality and the same facilities in terms of government affairs, there are still many prisoners and detainees who have not had the opportunity to participate in the 2019 presidential election. And there are several factors that influence a prisoner in providing rights. his vote in the 2019 Presidential Election in this research.*
