

## **ABSTRAK**

### **PENGARUH EKSPOR, IMPOR, BELANJA PEMERINTAH SEKTOR PENDIDIKAN, KRISIS MONETER (1997-1998) DAN PANDEMI COVID-19 TERHADAP PERTUMBUHAN EKONOMI DI INDONESIA PADA TAHUN 1994-2023**

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Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis pengaruh ekspor, impor, belanja pemerintah, serta pengaruh dari covid-19 dan krisis moneter tahun 1997-1998 terhadap pertumbuhan ekonomi Indonesia periode 1994-2023. Metode penelitian yang digunakan adalah deskriptif kuantitatif dengan menggunakan regresi linear berganda. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa: (1) Ekspor berpengaruh positif dan signifikan, (2) Impor berpengaruh negatif signifikan, (3) Belanja Pemerintah berpengaruh negatif signifikan (4) covid-19 berpengaruh negatif signifikan, (5) krisis moneter tahun 1997- 1998 berpengaruh negatif signifikan, (6) ekspor, impor, belanja pemerintah, covid-19, dan krisis moneter tahun 1997-1998 secara bersama sama berpengaruh terhadap pertumbuhan ekonomi Indonesia periode 1994-2023.

## **ABSTRACT**

### ***THE EFFECTS OF EXPORTS, IMPORTS, GOVERNMENT SPENDING IN THE EDUCATION SECTOR, THE MONETARY CRISIS VARIABLE (1997–1998), AND THE PANDEMIC COVID-19 VARIABLE ON ECONOMIC GROWTH IN INDONESIA FROM 1994 TO 2023***

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*This study aims to analyze the effects of exports, imports, and government spending, as well as the effects of the pandemic Covid-19 variable and the 1997–1998 monetary crisis variable on Indonesia’s economic growth during the period 1994–2023. The research method used is quantitative descriptive analysis employing multiple linear regression. The results of the study indicate that: (1) Exports have a positive and significant effect, (2) Imports have a significant negative effect, (3) Government spending has a significant negative effect, (4) the pandemic Covid-19 variable has a significant negative effect, (5) the 1997–1998 monetary crisis variable has a significant negative effect, (6) exports, imports, government spending, the Pandemic Covid-19 variable, and the 1997–1998 monetary crisis variable collectively influence Indonesia’s economic growth during the 1994–2023 period.*
